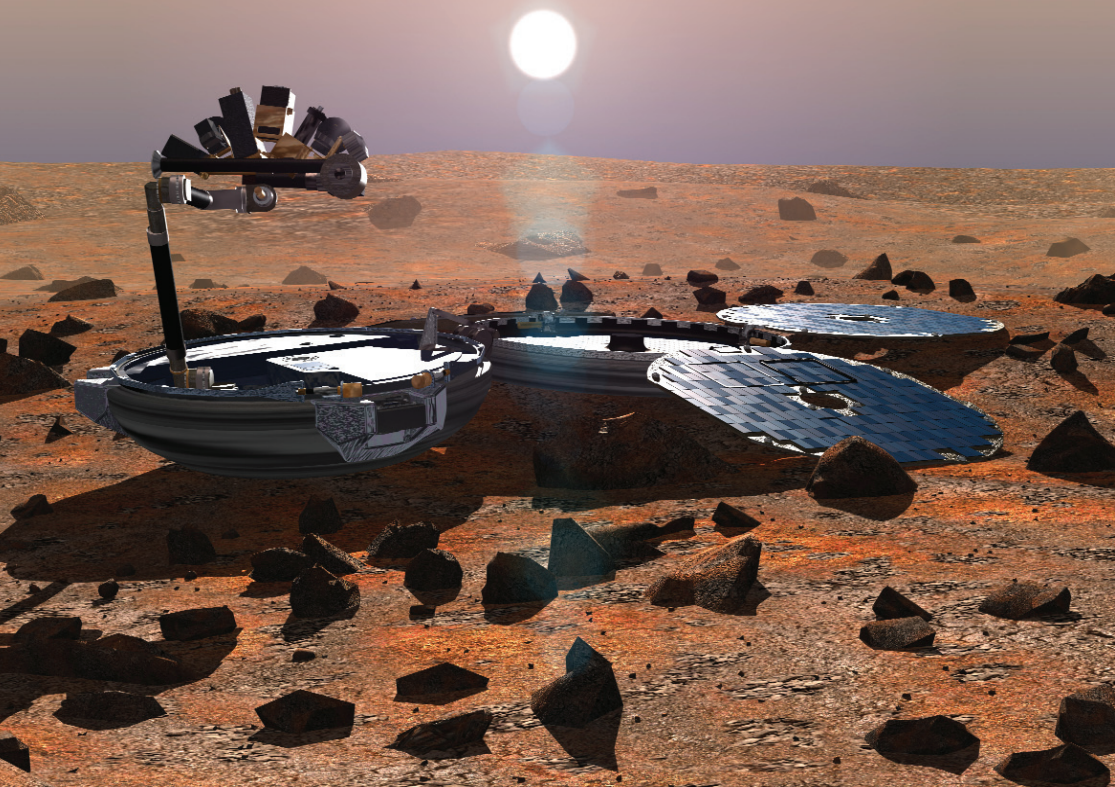

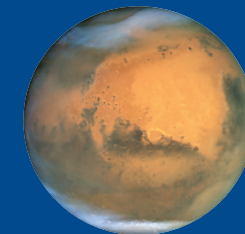

Beagle 2 was due to land on Mars on 25th December 2003. The spacecraft was ejected successfully from Mars Express on 19th December 2003 but nothing has been heard from the lander on the Martian surface and the mission is presumed lost. In spite of this, Mars Express has been very successful in its mission. Join
